ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Continental Oil Company, has made application to the Commission on May 12, 1965, for permission to expand its Eastcap Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Caprock-Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 27th day of May, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 1 located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 22,
Township 14 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That in the event the 5- $\frac{1}{2}$ inch casing fails to withstand the proposed 2,000 psi pressure test, applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 2500 feet in said well.
