ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2268-A, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company has made application to the Commission on September 15, 1965, for approval of casing and tubing programs for wells in Stages I and II and certain wells in Stage III, expansions of the Keel-West Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico,

NOW, on this 5th day of November, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that the State Engineer Office has been duly notified of the application.
3. That the casing and tubing programs of the wells listed in the application dated September 14, 1965, are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.
4. That application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg and San Andres formations through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

All wells in Stage I and Stage II and the following wells in Stage III:

Keel A-9, West A-13, Keel A-12, Keel A-10,  
West B-14, Keel B-28, Keel B-29, Keel B-17,  
and West B-17, as per application dated  
September 14, 1965.
