Gentlemen:

Great Western Drilling Company, Operator of the North Central Caprock Queen Unit, Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, requests administrative permission to convert Well in Section 18 No. 5, E, 13-S, 32-E, Lea County, from a producing well to an injection well.

The above well is currently non - commercial, producing 1 barrel of oil and 42 barrels of water daily. It has produced 62,205 barrels of secondary oil as of February 1, 1966.

The Unit Operators voted to convert the above well to see if more recovery of oil can be economically produced. This unit is in the last stages of secondary recovery. There are no direct offset operators to this producer. As an experiment in the search for an increase in oil from this unit we make this request.

A similar request was granted just a year ago on three producing wells. Since that time this unit has produced 61,444 barrels of oil.

Enclosed please find three plats of this area, indicating the status of all wells in the unit and offset operators. These operators are being sent waivers at this time.





GREAT WESTERN DRILLING COMPANY, OPERATOR




- Producing Well

I have before me a letter from Mr. O. H. Crews, Great Western Drilling Company of Midland, Texas and his application to the Oil Conservation Commission requesting administrative permission to convert well in Sec. 18 No. 5 E., 13-S, 32-E, Lea County, from a producing well to an injection well.

None of the information required under Oil Conservation Commission Rule 701-B was supplied with the application.
