APPLICATION OF AMERADA PETROLEUM CORPORATION TO EXPAND ITS LANGLIE MATTIX WOOLWORTH UNIT WATER FLOOD PROJECT IN THE LANGLIE-MATTIX POOL IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER WFX NO. 238

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Amerada Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on August 23, 1966, for permission to expand its Langlie Mattix Woolworth Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 7th day of September, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 5 Well No. 4 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 27,
Tract 7 Well No. 3 located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 27,
Tract 11 Well No. 8 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 33,
Tract 11 Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 33,
Tract 12 Well No. 2 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 34,
Tract 12 Well No. 5 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 34, and
Tract 14 Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 34, all in Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set well below the top of the cement surrounding production casing in said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
