ORDER WFX-239

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on September 14, 1966, for permission to expand its Pearsall Water Flood Project in the Pearsall-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 29th day of September, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Pearsall AX Well No. 4 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 33 and Pearsall A Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 33, both in Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM;

PROVIDED HOWEVER, The above described wells to be completed as shown in application dated September 12, 1966.
