ORDER WFX NO. 243

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Maxwell Oil Company has made application to the Commission on September 19, 1966, for permission to expand its North Shugart Water Flood Project in the Shugart Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 18th day of October, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Maxwell Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

A. C. Taylor "A" No. 2 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 12, Malco-Taylor "A" Well No. 4 located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 12, and A. C. Taylor "B" Well No. 3 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 13, all in Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM;

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set within 100 feet of the casing shoes on production casing in the above described wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
