ORDER WFX No. 261

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Anadarko Production Company has made application to the Commission on May 4, 1967, for permission to expand its Langlie-Mattix Penrose Sand Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 19th day of May, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Anadarko Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 13 C Well No. 5 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 27,
Tract 13 C Well No. 7 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 27,
Tract 18 Well No. 2 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 26,
Tract 19 Well No. 4 located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 27,
Tract 22 Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 27,
Tract 24 Well No. 4 located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 28,
Tract 33 Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 33, and
Tract 35 Well No. 3 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 33, all
in Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set as close to the bottom of production casing as is practicable in the above-described wells.
