Reference is made to your letter of the 10th day of August, 1964, regarding the proposed drilling of an oil well on the land owned by the Santa Fe Indian Tribe, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Enclosed for you are two copies of the proposed order of the Commission, one copy of which is being furnished to the Santa Fe Indian Tribe. The proposed order is based on the information furnished to the Commission by the Santa Fe Indian Tribe and the Bureau of Land Management, U.S. Department of the Interior.

The proposed order provides that the drilling of the well shall be subject to the following conditions: (1) The well shall be drilled and operated in accordance with the provisions of the Oil Conservation Act, 30 U.S.C. 1801-1812, and the rules and regulations thereunder; (2) The well shall be drilled and operated in accordance with the provisions of the Santa Fe Indian Tribe's Oil and Gas Lease Agreement with the Bureau of Land Management, U.S. Department of the Interior, dated August 1, 1964.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1433, Mercury Production Company has made application to the Commission on August 24, 1967, for permission to expand its Brown-Queen Water Flood Project in the Brown Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 13th day of September, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-1433.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1433.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Mercury Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

State E-92 Well No. 17, located in Unit K of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant is hereby authorized to convert to producing status, the following described well: State E-92 Well No. 18, located in Unit F of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, NMPM.
