ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3069, Tenneco Oil Company has made application to the Commission on March 15, 1968, for permission to expand its Grayburg-Jackson West Unit Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 30th day of March, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3069.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3069.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 55 located in Unit I of Section 16, and
Unit Well No. 57 located in Unit K of Section 16, both
in Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set just above the perforations in the production casing of said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
