ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3297, Gulf Oil Company - U. S. has made application to the Commission on September 3, 1968, for permission to expand its La Munyon Teague Water Flood Project in the Teague-Simpson Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 18th day of September, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3297.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3297.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Gulf Oil Company, -U.S., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the McKee formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

C. E. LaMunyon Well No. 9 located in Unit D and
C. E. LaMunyon Well No. 13 located in Unit F,
both in Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 37
East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set at approximately 9200 feet in the production casing of said wells.
