

APPLICATION OF AMERADA PETROLEUM CORPORATION TO EXPAND ITS LANGLIE MATTIX WOOLWORTH UNIT WATER FLOOD PROJECT IN THE LANGLIE MATTIX POOL IN LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER WFX-303

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Amerada Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on November 13, 1968, for permission to expand its Langlie Mattix Woolworth Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 28th day of November, 1968, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers-Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 103 located in Unit F of Section 28,
Unit Well No. 802 located in Unit F of Section 33,
Unit Well No. 151 located in Unit J of Section 34 and
a well to be drilled in Unit J of Section 33, all in Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set in the production strings in said wells.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
