ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2278, Skelly Oil Company has made application to the Commission on June 16, 1969, for permission to expand its Skelly Unit Water Flood Project in the Lovington-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 25th day of June, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2278.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2278.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the San Andres formation through the following-described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 47 located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 4570 feet in the production casing of said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
