ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Depco, Inc., has made application to the Commission on December 29, 1969, for permission to affect a change in its Depco Artesia Waterflood Project in the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, by replacement of an injection well.

NOW, on this 13th day of January, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for completion for water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Depco, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following-described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Artesia Unit Well No. 65 located in Unit G of
Section 3, Township 18 South, Range 28 East,
NMPM

Said Well No. 65 to be completed as an injection well in lieu of Unit Well No. 47.
