# ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2197-A, Amerada Hess Corporation has made application to the Commission on August 10, 1970, for permission to expand its Langlie Mattix Woolworth Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 25th day of August, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2197-A.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2197-A.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
  - 6. That the application should be approved.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amerada Hess Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Lower Seven Rivers-Queen formation through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

L.M.W.U. Well No. 113 located in Unit P of Section 33, L.M.W.U. Well No. 804 located in Unit D of Section 33, L.M.W.U. Well No. 902 located in Unit L of Section 33, L.M.W.U. Well No. 165 located in Unit N of Section 34, L.M.W.U. Well No. 166 located in Unit P of Section 34, and L.M.W.U. Well No. 003 located in Unit N of Section 33, all in Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the above-described wells will be converted or drilled and completed in accordance with the application dated August 5, 1970, and in compliance with Commission Order No. R-2197-A.
