ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2197-A, Amerada Hess Corporation has made application to the Commission on August 10, 1970, for permission to expand its Langlie Mattix Woolworth Unit Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 25th day of August, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2197-A.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2197-A.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amerada Hess Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Lower Seven Rivers-Queen formation through the following-described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

L.M.W.U. Well No. 113 located in Unit P of Section 33,  
L.M.W.U. Well No. 804 located in Unit D of Section 33,  
L.M.W.U. Well No. 902 located in Unit L of Section 33,  
L.M.W.U. Well No. 165 located in Unit N of Section 34,  
L.M.W.U. Well No. 166 located in Unit P of Section 34, and  
L.M.W.U. Well No. 003 located in Unit N of Section 33, all  
in Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the above-described wells will be converted or drilled and completed in accordance with the application dated August 5, 1970, and in compliance with Commission Order No. R-2197-A.
