
We have followed the procedure in Rule 701 B and are submitting the necessary attachments therein requested.





H & S Oil Company was authorized by the Commissioner to institute the West Artesia Grayburg Unit Waterflood in Eddy County, New Mexico, Order No. 3357, which was later amended by order No. 3357A.


H & S Oil Company now request administrative approval to convert the Signal # 12 well to injection and Signal # 11 well to production. We have encountered mechanical difficulties in the # 11 injection well due to communication between the metex zone and the premier zone. We feel that should we squeeze the two zones we might lose them both. The conversion would promote a better sweep and allow us to keep both zones moving.

There is attached to and made a part of this letter, a plat showing the unit area, and a diagramatic sketch of the proposed injection well showing casing strings, including diameters and setting depths, quantities of cement used and perforated intervals.

H & S Oil Company will appreciate your consideration of this request and will be awaiting an answer at your earliest convenience.


