ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Depco, Inc., has made application to the Commission on July 13, 1972, for permission to expand its Artesia Unit Water Flood Project in the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 28th day of July, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Depco, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Artesia Unit Well No. 8 located in Unit A of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 2100 feet.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
