ORDER WFX NO. 377

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4290, Jack L. McClellan has made application to the Commission on August 17, 1972, for permission to expand its Sulimar Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Sulimar-Queen Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 29th day of August, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That a waiver of objection has been received from the offsetting operator and the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701 may be dispensed with at this time.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4290.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Jack L. McClellan, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Tract 5 Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 26,  
Township 15 North, Range 29 East, NMMP,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 1925 feet.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
