ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER WFX NO. 382

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4419, Skelly Oil Company has made application to the Commission on November 13, 1972, for permission to expand its Grayburg-Jackson Skelly Unit Water Flood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 6th day of December, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4419.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4419.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Skelly Unit Well No. 3 located in Unit D of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That by the authority granted by Order R-4419, Skelly Oil Company is authorized to dually complete said Skelly Unit Well No. 3 in such a manner as to produce oil from the Fren-Seven Rivers Pool and to inject water in the Grayburg-San Andres formation through parallel strings of tubing with a permanent type packer set at approximately 3017 feet.
