ORDER WFX NO. 386

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701, Texas Pacific Oil Company has made application to the Commission on February 8, 1973, for permission to expand its South Leonard Queen Water Flood Project in the South Leonard-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 23rd day of February, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Texas Pacific Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Unit Well No. 8 located in Unit F of Section 24, Township 26
South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3309 feet in said well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
