ORDER WFX NO. 389

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4068, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on January 28, 1973, for permission to expand its South Eunice Unit Water Flood Project in the South Eunice Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 13th day of March, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That waivers of objection have been received from offsetting operators and the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4068 may be dispensed with in this instance.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Rule 701.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers-Queen formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

South Eunice Unit Well No. 5 located in Unit D  
South Eunice Unit Well No. 6 located in Unit B, and  
South Eunice Unit Well No. 7 located in Unit H, all in  
Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing and under packers as per the application dated February 26, 1973.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
