ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2403, Continental Oil Company has made application to the Commission on April 19, 1973, for permission to expand its MCA Unit Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 24th day of April, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2403-A.
3. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
4. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

MCA Unit Well No. 331 located in Unit D of Section 20,
Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County,
New Mexico.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 3581 feet in the above described well.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
