ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3910, Wood, McShane & Thams has made application to the Commission on September 6, 1973, for permission to expand its State "M" Lease Water Flood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 21st day of September, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3910.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3910.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Wood, McShane & Thams, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Well No. 30 located in Unit P of Section 19,  
Well No. 35 located in Unit B of Section 30, and  
Well No. 36 located in Unit P of Section 30, all  
in Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set below 3500 feet.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
