ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3984, Mobil Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on January 10, 1974, for permission to expand its Bridges State Water Flood Project in the Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 25th day of January, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3984.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3984.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Mobil Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg and San Andres formations through the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Bridges State Well No. 167, located in
Unit 0, Section 15, Township 17 South,
Range 34 East, NMPM.
