ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4680, Skelly Oil Company has made application to the Commission on July 7, 1975, for permission to expand its Skelly Myers Langlie Mattix Unit Waterflood Project in the Langlie-Mattix Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 22nd day of July, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4680.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4680.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced waterflood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Lower Seven Rivers and Queen formations through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 61, located in Unit C of Section 31,
Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 67, located in Unit E of Section 36, and
Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 101, located in Unit K of Section 36,
both in Township 23 South, Range 36 East, NMPM,
Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 173, located in Unit K of Section 6, and
Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 248, located in Unit M of Section 8,
both in Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
all in Lea County, New Mexico.
