ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3628-C, Anadarko Production Company has made application to the Commission on June 30, 1975, for permission to expand its Far West Loco Hills Sand Unit Water Flood Project in the Loco Hills Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 9th day of July, 1975, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That waivers of objection have been received from such offset operators.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3628-C.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Anadarko Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Loco Hills Sand formation through the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Well No. 9-10, located in Unit C, Section 9;
Well No. 9-14, located in Unit F, Section 9, and
Well No. 10-16, located in Unit L, Section 9, all in
Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County,
New Mexico.
