ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2635, Texas American Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on March 1, 1976, for permission to expand its Harlan-Queen Waterflood Project in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 16th day of March, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2635.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2635.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Texas American Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 1800 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Etz State "B" Well No. 6, located in Unit G of Section 16, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
