ORDER WFX NO. 434

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3154, Phillips Petroleum Company has made application to the Commission on March 8, 1976, for permission to expand its Northeast Maljamar Water Flood Project in the Maljamar Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 23rd day of March, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-3154.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3154.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Phillips Petroleum Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg-San Andres formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 4270 feet and 4300 feet respectively in the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

State E Well No. 5 located in Unit I of Section 8,  
and State E Well No. 10 located in Unit O of Section  
9, both in Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM,  
Lea County, New Mexico.
