ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3311, Depco, Inc. has made application to the Commission on May 10, 1976, for permission to expand its Highway Water Flood Project in the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 14th day of May, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That waivers of objection have been received from such offset operators.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3311.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Depco, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 2100 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recover, to wit:
