ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4214 and R-4290, McClellan Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on September 16, 1976, for permission to expand it Sulimar-Oueen Unit Water Flood Project in the Sulimar-Oueen Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 20th day of September, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
- 3. That the proposed injection well is eliqible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order Mo. R-4214 and R-4290.
- 4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 5. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, McClellan Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Oueen formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 1910 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Sulimar-Oueen Unit Tract I Well No. 12, located in Unit C, Section 24, Township 15 South, Pange 29 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.
