ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4214 and R-4290, McClellan Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on September 16, 1976, for permission to expand its Sulimar-Queen Unit Water Flood Project in the Sulimar-Queen Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 20th day of September, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators.
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4214 and R-4290.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, McClellan Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 1910 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Sulimar-Queen Unit Tract I Well No. 12, located
in Unit C, Section 24, Township 15 South, Range
29 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.
