ORDER WFX NO. 442

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-5168, Burluson & Huff has made application to the Commission on November 15, 1976, for permission to expand its Querecho Plains-Queen Water Flood Project in the Querecho Plains-Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 16th day of November, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other offset operators;
3. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-5168.
4. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the application should be approved.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Burluson & Huff, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Queen formation through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 3900 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Anadarko Federal Well No. 6, located in Unit N
of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 32 East,
NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.
