Under the provisions of Order Mo. R-3421, Texas Pacific Oil Company, Inc has made application to the Commission on January 20, 1977, for permission to expand its South Leonard Oueen Water Flood Project in the South Leonard-Oueen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

MOW, on this 17th day of February, 1977, the Secretary-Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed in due form.
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- 3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. 2-3421.
- 4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-3421.
- 5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
 - 6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Texas Pacific Oil Company, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Oueen formation through plastic-lined tubing set in packers at approximately 3200 feet and 3300 feet, respectively, in the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

South Leonard Oueen Unit Well Mo. 6, Unit H, Section 23 and South Leonard Oueen Unit Well No. 15, Unit M, Section 24, both in Township 26 South, Range 37 Fast, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the operator shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval and is not permitted to escape to other formations or onto the surface.

That the casing-tubing annulus shall be loaded with an inert fluid and equipped with a pressure gauge at the surface or left open to the atmosphere to facilitate detection of leakage in the casing, tubing, or packer.

That the operator shall notify the supervisor of the Commission's Hobbs District Office before injection is commenced

That the operator shall immediately notify the supervisor of the Commission's Hobbs Office of the failure of the tubing, casing, or packer in said well or the leakage of water from or around said well and shall take such steps as may be timely or necessary to correct such failure or leakage.
