

Gentlemen:

We respectfully request administrative approval to convert an additional well to waterflood injection service and to enlarge the waterflood project area of the captioned operation as provided by Order No. R-3154. We propose to convert the Phillips-E State No. 24 (F-14-17S-33E) to injection service and to enlarge the project area by adding the NW/4, N/2 SW/4, NW/4 SE/4, W/2 NE/4, Section 14, all in T-17-S, R-33-E, Lea County. A combination of produced and fresh water make-up will be injected into the well number 24 at approximately 200 barrels per day at 2700 psi surface injection pressure. ✓

Enclosed is a lease plat which reflects the current project area and the area of expansion, with well number 24 spotted within the latter. In addition, we enclose an electric log and a schematic of the proposed completion of well number 24.




