
Reference is made to your request of September 9, 1986 to increase the surface injection pressure on two wells within your Myers Langlie Mattix Unit. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on the wells during August, 1986. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase your surface injection pressure on the following wells:

<u>Well &amp; Location</u>	<u>Maximum Injection Surface Pressure</u>
Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 185, 660 FSL & 660 FWL, (Unit M), Sec. 3, T-24S, R37E	1350 PSIG
Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 189, 660 FSL & 660 FWL, (Unit M), Sec. 2, T-24S, R37E	950 PSIG

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or it is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
