
Reference is made to your request dated January 17, 1989, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Myers Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 167. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on November 11, 1988. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on the well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

<u>WELL AND LOCATION</u>	<u>MAXIMUM INJECTION SURFACE PRESSURE</u>
Myers Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 167 Unit I, Section 5, T-24 South, R-37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.	1350 PSIG

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
