Dear Mr. Miller:

Reference is made to your request to increase the surface injection pressure on all wells in the above-referenced Burch-Keely Cooperative Waterflood Project. This request is based on step rate tests conducted previously in this project. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel a field-wide increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure to a maximum of 900 psi each, on thirty-two authorized injection wells in the subject waterflood project in Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
