Reference is made to your request dated July 15, 1988, to increase the surface injection pressure on three wells within the North Vacuum Abo Unit Waterflood Proejct. This request is based on step rate tests conducted on these wells on June 22-23, 1988. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.
