Dear Mr. Newport:


Reference is made to your request dated September 28, 1993 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate tests conducted on this well on September 11, 1993. The results of the test has been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

Well and Location	Maximum Injection Surface Pressure
Eunice Monument Well No. 28 330' FSL - 330' FWL Unit M, Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 37 East	1460 PSIG
This well located in Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
