

Dear Sir:

Yates Drilling Company completed the captioned well as a producing well on August 26, 1992. We converted the well to a water injection well by authority of Administrative Order WFX-640 dated February 1, 1993.

In June, 1993 we hydraulically fractured the well with 18,654 gallons of gelled water and 33,600# 12/20 sand and converted it from an injection well to a pumping well. We would now like to return the well to an injection well. The information on the C-108 we furnished in January, 1992 is still correct. The only thing that has changed is the stimulation on well #29.

We respectfully request that you reinstate the permit for the South Loco Hills #29 to be a water injection well. If you need any further information, please contact me.
