***Re: Corrections and Amendments to Division Orders WFX-679 and WFX-681.***

Dear Mr. Jackson:

Reference is made to your recent letters requesting certain corrections and amendments to the subject orders. My staff has reviewed the data included with your requests and such corrections and amendments are hereby made as follows:

***Amendment to Division Order WFX-679*** - Due to partially collapsed or parted casing in the H.E. West 'B' Well No.27, the well shall be completed by running 5 ½ inch casing to approximately 3885 feet and cemented with 300 sacks. The well will be perforated in the interval from 3050 feet to 3885 feet with the packer set at approximately 2950 feet. All other provisions of WFX-679 shall remain in full force and effect.

***Correction to Division Order WFX-681*** - The injection interval in the H.E. West 'B' Well No.6 shall be changed to include perforations and open hole to extend from 3126 feet to 3868 feet. All other provisions of WFX-681 shall remain in full force and effect.
