Dear Mr. Jackson:

Reference is made to your recent application to expand your Keel-West Unit Waterflood Project in Eddy County, New Mexico.

In reviewing the application, it became apparent that some additional information will be needed. As you are aware, all the wellbores within one-half mile of each proposed injector are reviewed for construction details. Further, all plugged and abandoned wells require a schematic be included with the application. 12 wells in the area of review were identified as being P&A'd. Schematics of 3 of them were included. 3 others were in the area of review for a previous expansion under WFX-665, so I was able to get these schematics. This leaves 6 wells needing schematics as follows:


