ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-2214, Pan American Petroleum Corporation has made application to the Commission on November 16, 1967, for permission to expand its Southeast Cha Cha Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 6th day of December, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-2214.
4. That the proposed injection wells are eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-2214.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described wells for purposes of pressure Maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 9 located in Unit N of Section 9 and  
Unit Well No. 15 located in Unit P of Section 15,  
both in Township 28 North, Range 13 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with packers set just above the perforations in the production casing in said wells.
