ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4430, Mobil Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on June 15, 1973, for permission to expand its North Vacuum-Abo Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the North Vacuum-Abo Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 2nd day of July, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order No. R-4430.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4430.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant, Mobil Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Abo formation through the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 175 located in Unit H of Section 14,
Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set at approximately 8434 feet in said well.
