ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-4430, Mobil Oil Corporation has made application to the Commission on September 10, 1973, for permission to expand its North Vacuum Abo Pressure Maintenance Project in the North Vacuum-Abo Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 13th day of September, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to gas and water injection under the terms of Order No. R-4430.
3. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced pressure maintenance project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
4. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Mobil Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject gas and water into the Abo formation through the following described well for purposes of pressure maintenance, to wit:

Unit Well No. 175 located in Unit H of Section 14,  
Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.
