Dear Sir:

Atlantic Richfield has been disposing of the produced water that is produced in the Empire Abo Field in the Empire Abo Unit C-49 as per NMOCC Order No. PMX 58 dated 05/16/74. This is Abo formation water being disposed of in the Abo formation below the water-oil contact.

We also had previously obtained approval from the NMOCC and USGS to dispose of produced water from the Empire Abo Field in wells EAU B-48 and C-50. These are back-up wells for the EAU C-49 well. We recently converted the EAU C-50 well located in Unit K, Section 29, T 17 S, R 29 E, Eddy County, New Mexico as a disposal well into the Abo formation. We finished connecting the well to the injection plant and commenced disposing of produced water from the Empire Abo Field November 1, 1978.
