Gentlemen:

Please refer to attached copy of case No. 4015, Order No. R 3657. Under paragraph 3 of Order, the Secretary-Director of the Commission is authorized to approve additional salt water disposal wells in Wilson Yates-Seven Rivers Pool.

Wilson Oil Company State #9, Unit F of Section 13, T 21S, R 34E will not take salt water for disposal in sufficient quantities and reasonable pressure into the seven-rivers reef. HCL acid has been used to increase the rate of take. The well will take the salt water at normal rates, thus the well will be retained in disposal system to receive most of the fluid.

Wilson Oil Company hereby requests the addition of State 7 in Unit K of Section 13, T 21S, R 34E to salt water disposal system for excess fluid.

Permission is also requested to permit the disposal of Salt water trucked to the location from isolated wells in the area.

Raymond, please file for salt water disposal for your station 7 well on our Form C-108 accompanied by a schematic diagram and we will be happy to process the application. Also, we will need the statement that disposal will be into the Gains and 7 Rivers formations only to comply w/ Order R-3657.

As to bringing water in from isolated wells and on other leases and disposing into these wells, we are not concerned about that, but I think you should clear it with the landowner on the disposal well.
