SUBJECT: SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL

ORDER NO. SWD-118

THE APPLICATION OF CORINNE GRACE  
FOR A SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) Corinne Grace, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 11, 1971, for permission to complete for salt water disposal her Salty Bill Well No. 1 located in Unit C of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, South Carlsbad Field, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.
4. That waivers of objection have been received from the offsetting operators and the waiting period prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with at this time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant herein, Corinne Grace, is hereby authorized to complete her Salty Bill Well No. 1 located in Unit C of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, South Carlsbad Field, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Delaware formation under a packer and into the open-hole interval from approximately 1800 feet to approximately 2050 feet through 2 1/16-inch tubing and to permit the injection of fresh water into the salt section for brine recovery purposes through a parallel string of 2 1/16-inch tubing above the packer.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall set the 5 1/2-inch disposal casing string in the Delaware formation and cement said string back into the base of the salt section;

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the applicant shall set a DV Tool at the top of the salt section and cement the 5 1/2-inch casing string back to the surface.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or

THE PROVISIONS OF CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS FOR A SAIT WATER DISPOSAL PERMIT

Under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) Contingency Order No. 100-100, for application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 11, 1971, for permission to dispose of salt water disposal Unit 2 of Section 30, Township 33 North, Range 10 East, MPM, South Central Field, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Executive finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operations, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified;

3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met;

4. That surveys of objection have been received from the offsetting operations and the waiting period prescribed by this rule may be dispensed with at this time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant herein, Contingency Order No. 100-100, be authorized to complete the Salt Water Well No. 1 located on Unit 2 of Section 30, Township 33 North, Range 10 East, MPM, South Central Field, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Delaware formation under a packer and into the open hole interval from approximately 1000 feet to approximately 100 feet through 2 1/2-inch casing and to permit the injection of fresh water into the salt section for brine recovery purposes through a parallel string of 2 1/2-inch casing above the packer.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall set the 2 1/2-inch disposal casing string in the Delaware formation and cement said string back into the base of the salt section;

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the applicant shall set the 2 1/2-inch casing string at the top of the salt section and cement the 2 1/2-inch casing string back to the surface.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the protection of waste water.

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protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
