ORDER NO. SWD-122

THE APPLICATION OF YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION FOR A SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) Yates Petroleum Corporation, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 16, 1971, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Jackson AT Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations:
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.
4. That all offsetting properties are leased by Yates Petroleum Corporation, thus in the absence of offsetting operators the waiting period prescribed by Rule 701 (C) may be dispensed with at this time.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Yates Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to complete its Jackson AT Well No. 2 located in Unit N of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation at approximately 1322 feet to approximately 1403 feet through 2-3/8 inch tubing with a packer set at approximately 1300 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
