ORDER NO. SWD-125

THE APPLICATION OF WILSON OIL  
COMPANY FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELLS.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Order No. R-3657, Wilson Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 21, 1972, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Wilson-State Well No. 19 located in Unit G of Section 23 and its Amerada-State Well No. 3 located in Unit G of Section 13, both in Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Order No. R-3657 of the Commission;
2. That Wilson Oil Company is the only operator in the Wilson Yates-Seven Rivers Pool; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Order R-3657 will be met.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the applicant herein, Wilson Oil Company, is hereby authorized to complete its Wilson-State Well No. 19 located in Unit G of Section 23 and its Amerada-State Well No. 3 located in Unit G of Section 13, both in Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Yates and Seven Rivers formations at approximately 3435 feet to approximately 3900 feet through 2-1/2 inch tubing and the oil strings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
